# 2014-17 NEW CONTRACT UPDATES

#### **LUMP SUM PAYMENT**

All permanent contract teachers should have rec'd their lump sum payments on Feb 2nd. This includes all retro grid pay from Sept 3rd to Feb 2nd. Your pay period cheque should have had a record of your updated category A3 etc and experience Step and Days (Step 5 Days 122). The Days reflects the amount of full days worked in addition to full years. The Step reflects your Years remember we start at 0. So Step 5 would reflect 6 full years of teaching.

The OTs will receive their lump sum after the end of the year when they calculate how many days you have worked in total. All OTs in an LTO for first semester should have had a grid movement as of their QECO and Experience on Sept 3rd.

All teachers on a paid leave such as a Mat leave should have also been paid their lump sum by Feb 9th. Any work they did

between Sept 3rd and Feb 2nd should also have been recorded as a grid payment for days worked. If you have questions let us know.

#### **OT KEYS AND BOOKLETS**

It is extremely important that all OTs on daily supply receive the necessary keys they need to do their assignment. It is also a duty of the office to provide a detailed booklet that has supervision schedules, duplicate class lists needed, seating plan where appropriate, bell times, medical concerns for identified students in the classroom and any other relevant information pertaining to the class.

These booklets are to be kept in the office and handed out each morning and handed back at the end of their assignment.

If you are an OT and are not given keys and/or booklets please inform the OECTA Office. Reps please check this status with your administrator.

#### **REP SITE STAFF MEETINGS**

OECTA and the Board are working together to collect the Best Practices used when staffing is prepared for the next school year and next semester. Currently a sub-committee of Joint Staffing is discussing how to implement the new contract. Teacher Reps will be given a chance several times a year to discuss school staffing with the Principal and VPs.

A week prior to the proposed meeting the OECTA Reps will be given the required staffing information. They will then have a meeting with their administrative team to examine what options are available for possible grades/subjects.

The Board and OECTA will have more information on the process in the upcoming month. The Executive will discuss the process with your Reps and they will bring information to you this month and more in April. Stay Tuned.....

## H and S Reporting Safe Schools Act and Incidents

Student Behaviour Concerns? Getting Kicked, Slapped, Spit On, Bit, Ducking Thrown Objects, Sworn At?

Then there are reports YOU MUST file!

The Safe Schools Act requires you to fill out a report for **EVERY** incident that happens that **could lead** to a suspension or more. Some of these include:

- \*Threats to inflict serious bodily harm on another person
- \*Possessing alcohol or illegal drugs
- \*Being under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs
- \*Swearing at a teacher or person in a position of authority \*Vandalism \*Bullying
- \*Any conduct injurious to the moral tone of the school or to the physical or mental well being of others.
- \*Persistent Truancy \*Persistent Opposition to Authority
  \*Willful Destruction of School Property \*Theft
- \*Was at Destruction of School Property
- \*Use of Profane/Improper Language \*Use of Tobacco
- \*Aid/Incite Harmful Behaviour
- \*Fighting
- \*Physical Assault/Sexual or Racial Harassment
- \*Distribution of Hate Material or Hate Motivated Violence
- \*Inappropriate Use of Electronic Media/Communication

#### There is **NO GREY** area.

Teachers are legally required to fill out the forms. Please ask your OECTA Reps for advice.

In addition most times an Incident Report will also need to be filled out to report injury and incidents to H and S
