Staff Rep Elections

As the year winds down it is time to consider who will be your OECTA Staff Association Rep for next year. Though some staffs have their elections at the end of June most decide to have their elections in September. We ask all Staff Reps to be selected before the 9th of September.

Staff Reps must be selected during an OECTA <u>only</u> meeting. OECTA Reps are never to be on a sign up sheet as Extra-Curricular. The meeting must be announced in advance. If there is more than one candidate for the position there must be an election. All elections will be by secret ballot. The Executive is available to help in any election if a staff wishes assistance.

Secondary and larger Elementary schools usually have two Reps. It is suggested that every site have a back up Rep to attend meetings if the Rep can't make a meeting. Meetings for the Reps generally take place on the last Monday of the month. There are no Rep meetings in December or June.

SICK LEAVE NOTES AND MEDICALS

Did you know that if the Board requires you to provide a medical form for an absence that the Board MUST pay for it and will reimburse you? In addition, all forms that they send out to your doctor whether directly or through you must also be reimbursed to you by the Board. This policy is new and came into effect last year. Please ask for the reimbursement expense forms and ask to be paid back!

REMEMBER

Every 100% permanent teachers have 11 sick days and 5 Specialized Days. They also have 120 days of short term illness at 90% pay. These days are pro-rated for part timers. LTO's please contact us.
