## **PROVINCIAL AND LOCAL NEGOTIATIONS**

As most of you are aware the Provincial June election had ramifications for our contracts and the bargaining process. The return of the Liberals heralds the first implementation of Bill 122 and Provincial Bargaining as a new fact of life for all teachers in the Province. Only after Provincial Bargaining announces the Provincial issues and responsibilities will Local Bargaining be able to start. Obviously the vast amount of issues that contain any kind of financial implications will be decided at the Provincial table. After these contract items are selected by Provincial we can then focus on other issues at the local level.

Bill 122 will require OECTA, the Boards/Trustees and the Ministry (Government) to sit at the table and hopefully work these issues out. This time OECTA now has implemented a required ratification vote Province wide to accept any contract deal made at the Provincial table. This is a change that the Provincil AGM in 2013 passed to ensure all members get an opportunity to vote on their contract. This is why it is so important for OECTA to have a non-school board email address.

However, no one should be under any illusions that this round will be easy or better. We still have the Liberal budget that had no real money increases for our wages and continues to enforce the 97th day for all AQ and Grid movements. At the present time we have not had any official updates on any bargaining issues. Unofficially we have heard everything from no serious talks have taken place to some preliminary talks have started. As August continues we expect some meetings at the Provincial level will start.

Only after these talks begin and we are given the list of topics that are not to be on the Provincial table will we be able to start Local negotiations. OECTA Provincial President James Ryan has told the Locals that we should not be ready to start our negotiations until we return to school. This will not be the first time OECTA has started the year without a contract.

We, as your Unit Executive, will update you as soon as we hear of anything even if it is to say that we are aware contract talks have begun at the Provincial level. Sometimes members may think Mark, David and Peter know more about what is happening. We wish it was true. You know everything we do. If meetings are called we will up date you to let you know. If we are called to Provincial for a special meeting we will also make you aware of that immediately.

## **ASSOCIATION REPS - ELECTIONS**

#### Wellington OECTA needs a few good Reps!

As we prepare to enter a new school year it is time to elect new OECTA staff association reps. We know some schools had an OECTA meeting at the end of June and this was done. If your school or site did not please conduct the election meeting in early September. Rep meetings will usually be held the last Monday of each month except December and June at 4:30 at the OECTA Office. We would ask that previous reps facilitate the election and that the name of each rep be forwarded to us as soon as possible. Some larger schools elect two reps to share the duties. There are many schools that also elect an alternate rep as well. It is important to have a rep at every school to help provide a vital communication link with the OECTA Executive.

We would like to thank all of last year's reps for their service to their fellow members. Reps are the front line workers of our local Unit and are vital to OECTA. Association Rep **Elections**: **Meetings** must be called in advance with notice and conducted with only members present. The Association Reps for all school and nonsite members should be completed by September 15th.
