REPS FOR 2017-18

All schools need to elect their Reps by Friday Sept 8th. This can be done at an OECTA meeting to be held in June or at the beginning of the school year. Current Reps should arrange a time for members to meet and give notice to every OECTA member on staff. They may say they are going to stand for re-election. The Executive cannot stress how important the role of the Rep is at each and every site. Your enforcement of your rights and contracts starts with each staff letting their Rep know of any concerns. You have the right for local staffing meetings and the right to ensure all timetables are assigned according to the contract. The Office cannot enforce the contract if we do not know there are inconsistencies or problems at a site. Please consider being the rep, co -rep or a backup. We value your service and your colleagues need your leadership and assistance!

To do List for September

Each September every teacher needs to keep track of many details for their students. However, there are details you should also be aware of and checking or keeping track of:

*Are your supervision minutes appropriate to your contract percentage Full Time: Elem 80 mins max per week or Sec 75 mins max every two weeks *Are your teaching minutes calculated correctly based on your panel : Elem your percentage is based on 1500 minutes including your planning time *Keep track of your oncalls at Secondary and keep track of lost planning time at Elementary

*TICs keep track of your days and half days and remember to get reimbursed for each half day or full day after the max has been surpassed

*Elect your H and S Rep at each site *Elect your Staff Rep on Parent Council at each site

*Elect your OECTA staff Rep at each site or for your group
