2018 UNIT AGM

The Wellington Catholic Unit AGM was held on May 17. In addition to receiving the report of the Elections Chair and electing our final councillor for the 2018-19 school year we reviewed the updated financial report up to April 30th. We also presented a synopsis of what are committees have been working on or what goals are in place for the next school year. If there were any changes to our bylaws and constitutions they would have been discussed and voted on at this time. (There were no changes this year).

At this meeting we confirm and vote to approve our officer release time and our attached allowances. The President will once again have 100% release time paid through Provincial OECTA. The Vice Presidents from Secondary and Elementary will both be released 50% and that is also paid through Provincial OECTA. All three release officers will release the Provincial Allowance, with two paid by Provincial funding and the other through local funding.

Posting and Vacancies

During June we will head into third round postings for permanent jobs and LTO positions. At the end of May we (OECTA and H R) place our surplus teachers. After that all teachers may begin applying for positions. If you are an OT on the LTO list with a successful TPA you are eligible to apply to permanent and LTO positions. However, for permanent jobs they may go to permanent contract teachers first before going to the LTO list.

If you were placed because you were surplus to your site you keep the rights to recall until Sept 1st unless you apply and are successful to another posting.

Note from July 15 to August 15 H R, the Principals and OECTA shut down hiring for the summer weeks.

OECTA REPS FOR 2018-2019

The need for an Association Rep at every school and site is very important for a healthy union. Our OECTA Staff Reps are the front line eyes and ears of our union and our Executive Officers direct line into each staff. Ideally we would like at least one Rep and one Alternate to be at each school. This helps new members learn their rights and their contract. It also ensures that the contract is working and more importantly being respected.

We at the office can't help what we never hear about. We can't change what we don't know about. We as a collective can't improve our contract if what we have is not protected and enforced. Some teachers say we don't need to worry about the contract. Everything in it is there for a reason. Would you agree to work for less than what you deserve on the Grid? No. All our rights are the same. These may have taken, in some cases, many years of negotiating to win that right.

We know some Reps have tough jobs. We know some administrators hinder or hamper the process. We have heard our Reps being told 'Why do you want to be the OECTA Rep' or 'Oh you will probably call OECTA' or worst of all 'Why did you call OECTA'. We call OECTA as we are unionized. We call OECTA to ensure our legal contract is enforced and our rights our protected.

Please consider nominating a Rep at your school. Please consider being the Rep at your school or become the Alternate Rep so you can learn the role for later. Every Rep should have someone on site that they can ask for help whether it is in collecting info from the school or more importantly attending our monthly OECTA meetings when the Rep cannot make one.

The Rep should be chosen in June or early September at an OECTA only Staff meeting. Nominations should take place. You can nominate yourself. If more than one volunteers a vote may be needed or they can decide to share the role. If you need assistance in this process please call.


