Contract 101

We have been receiving several calls and emails regarding the state of your pay and the new expected increases. The lump sum payment for all pre-Sept 8 permanent employees will be given 30 days following our Local Ratification. You will also receive retro pay to Sept 1st at that time if you are still on the grid as the 97th day is rescinded.

OTs and LTOs hired as of Sept 8 will receive their 1% lump sum based on the number of days they worked this year in July. They will be eligible for retro pay from Sept 1st as well according to their grid.

Negotiations have started though we are off to a slow start due to schedules of coordinating the various groups in our board. At the time of this newsletter only two OECTA locals have reached a tentative local agreement. Our next date to bargain is Nov 11th and then two more dates in Dec. Our OTs have their first date set for Dec.

Remember anything that was a central contract agreement will not be discussed at the local bargaining table. There is no change for sick days, LTD or benefits at the present time so status quo applies.
