# AGM 2015 RESULTS

The Provincial Annual General Meeting (AGM) was held at the beginning of March Break. Over 640 delegates represented OECTA Units from all across the Province. The AGM is the highest authority of our union and meets every March Break to determine the course our Union, OECTA, is heading in. At the AGM we also elect our Provincial Executive and set our Union Fees for the year.

Here are some quick notes

#### Fee Debate

The Fee Debate opened with several motions that would have led to an increase of almost a \$100 or led to specific increases over a certain amount of time based on any increases teacher's receive. These were turned down as we need 67% support to pass financial increases. We managed on the third day to pass a modest \$50 dollar increase to the fee. (A little under \$2 a pay) The Base Fee has not been raised in over a decade and this will help maintain services.

#### NOTE SEE MARCH FOR INFORMATION ON SURPLUS STAFFING

Grievances, arbitration, labour, EI, employment insurance, WSIB, health and safety

Members of OECTA's Contract Services department deal with all aspects of Employment Insurance problems, long-term disability, grievance/arbitration matters, the Workers' Safety and Insurance Board and health and safety issues.

The Ontario Labour Relations Act provides for the arbitration of grievances arising from the application, interpretation or violation of the collection agreement.

Any member who has reason to suspect that the <u>collective agreement</u> has not been applied, interpreted or administered in accordance with its terms, should immediately contact the Association's representative in the school, the unit's grievance officer, or the provincial office.

David Derewianko is our Unit's grievance officer. He works hard to ensure our contract is being followed and respected. However, he needs your help. If you think your contract language is being ignored, abused or misinterpreted please give David a call.

We can't help if you don't tell your Rep or inform the office of the nature of a concern .
