CONTRACT 101 HIRING

Differences between Permanent and OT Hiring Procedures:

There have been several calls from members asking why they were not given an interview for a permanent job. The 'top five' procedure of the OT hiring by seniority does not apply to the Permanent contract. For Permanent Teachers there are several numbers that are important.

- There need to be at least 3 permanent non-system (FSL/SERT) teachers for a posting or the administrator can ask for more candidates. The members still receive an interview. The LTO list will be added to make it a list of five applicants in total.
- If there are only I or 2 permanent teachers the administrator can decide to interview and hire one of them without going to the LTO List.
- However, even if I classroom teacher and 3 system teachers apply the Board can choose to ask for more applications and only I teacher is considered since the other 3 were system.

For our LTO postings or Perm postings without permanent teachers we still interview by qualifications and by seniority. The top five will be given an interview and one of them will be hired.

Hiring Criteria as stated in the staffing process is equally based on qualifications, seniority, curriculum, the needs of the school, past teaching experiences and the needs of the applicant.
